Resolution No. 35 - 16

***RESOLUTION OF THE AGENCY APPROVING AN INCREASE IN THE
AUTHORIZED SALES AND USE TAX ABATEMENT RELATING TO THE
METALLIZED CARBON CORPORATION ("COMPANY") PROJECT***

WHEREAS, by Title 1 of Article 18-A of the General Municipal Law of the State of New York ("State"), as amended, and Chapter 560 of the Laws of 1970 of the State, as amended and codified as Section 960 of the General Municipal Law (collectively, the "Act"), the Agency was created with the authority and power to own, lease and sell property as authorized by the Act; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to General Municipal Law Section 859-a, on April 4, 2016, at 11:15 a.m. local time, at the Town of Fallsburg Court Room, 19 Railroad Plaza, South Fallsburg, Sullivan County, New York, the Agency held a public hearing with respect to the Project and the proposed Financial Assistance being contemplated by the Agency ("Public Hearing") whereat interested parties were provided a reasonable opportunity, both orally and in writing, to present their views; and

WHEREAS, on or about June 20, 2016, the Company and the Agency entered into an Agent Agreement ("Agent Agreement") and an Environmental Compliance and Indemnification Agreement ("ECIA") and entered into a Bill of Sale to Agency, Bill of Sale to Company, Lease to Agency, Leaseback to Company and Payment in Lieu of Tax Agreement; and

WHEREAS, on or about July 1, 2016, the Company and the Agency closed a lease/leaseback transaction consisting of the: (i) acquisition, construction, installation and equipping of an approximately 15,000± square foot building intended to be used to manufacture carbon-graphite materials ("Building") situate on one (1) parcel of real estate consisting of approximately 7.2 acres located on Glen Wild Road, Town of Fallsburg ("Town"), Woodbridge, County of Sullivan ("County"), State and identified on the Town tax map as Section 65, Block 1, Lot 9 being more particularly described as Proposed Lot # 2 consisting of approximately 7.49 +/- acres located in the GlenWild Industrial Subdivision, Town, Woodbridge, County, State. Said Subdivision was filed in the office of the County Clerk on June 15, 2016 in Cabinet 14 at Line 391 ("Land"); (ii) acquisition, construction and equipping of the Building; (iii) acquisition, construction and installation thereon and therein of certain furniture, fixtures, machinery, equipment and tools ("Equipment"); (iv) construction of improvements to the Building, the Land and the Equipment (collectively, the Building, the Land and the Equipment are referred to as the "Facility" or the "Project"); and (v) lease of the Project from the Agency to the Company; and

WHEREAS, by resolution duly adopted on June 20, 2016, the Agency approved the Project and in connection therewith authorized a sales and use tax exemption in an amount not to exceed Thirty-Four Thousand and 00/100 (\$34,000.00) Dollars; and

WHEREAS, due to design changes and cost overruns, the cost of the Project will exceed the amounts listed in the application originally submitted; and

WHEREAS, on July 22, 2016, the Company presented the Agency with a Revised Application whereby the Company requested an increase in the authorized amount of the sales and use tax exemption to Two Hundred Two Thousand Six Hundred Thirty-Seven and 00/100 (\$202,637.00) Dollars; and

WHEREAS, the direct and indirect benefits to the local economy of additional construction activity far exceeds to cost of the increased sales and use tax exemption.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MEMBERS OF THE AGENCY AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Agency hereby approves the Company's request to increase the authorized sales and use tax abatement to an amount not to exceed Two Hundred Two Thousand Six Hundred Thirty-Seven and 00/100 (\$202,637.00) Dollars conditioned upon the amendment of the Agent Agreement to increase the Escrow Deposit to Twenty-Five Thousand and 00/100 (\$25,000.00) Dollars and further conditioned upon payment of all fees and costs of the Agency related hereto.

Section 2. The Executive Director, Chief Executive Officer or Counsel to the Agency is hereby authorized and directed (i) to distribute copies of this resolution to the Company; and (ii) to do such further things or perform such acts and to execute any and all documents as may be necessary or convenient to implement the provisions of this resolution.

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
