#### Resolution No. 16 - 17

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING THE EXECUTION AND DELIVERY OF A MORTGAGE (AND RELATED FINANCING DOCUMENTS) IN FAVOR OF CATSKILL HUDSON BANK ("BANK") IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$250,000.00 DOLLARS RELATING TO THE PESTECH EXTERMINATING, INC. ("PESTECH") AND DAVIDSON SULLIVAN REALTY, LLC ("DAVIDSON" AND TOGETHER WITH PESTECH COLLECTIVELY, THE "COMPANY") PROJECT

WHEREAS, by Title 1 of Article 18-A of the General Municipal Law of the State of New York ("State"), as amended, and Chapter 560 of the Laws of 1970 of the State, as amended and

codified as Section 960 of the General Municipal Law (collectively, the "Act"), the Agency was created with the authority and power to own, lease and sell property as authorized by the Act; and

WHEREAS, on or about June 1, 2008, the Company and the Agency closed a lease/leaseback transaction consisting of the: (i) acquisition, construction, installation and equipping of a building to consist of approximately 4,500 square feet ("Building") situate on one (1) parcel of real estate consisting of 2.00 ± acres located at 461 Harris Road in the Town of Liberty, County of Sullivan, State of New York and identified on the Town of Liberty tax map as Section 37, Block 1, Lot 39 ("Land"); (ii) acquisition and installation thereon and therein of certain furniture, fixtures, machinery, equipment and tools ("Equipment"); and (iii) acquisition, construction and equipping of improvements to the Building, the Land and the Equipment (collectively, the Building, the Land and the Equipment are referred to as the "Facility" or the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to a Commitment Letter, dated February 8, 2017, the Bank has approved a commercial line of credit in an amount not to exceed TWO HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND AND 00/100 (\$250,000.00) DOLLARS; and

*WHEREAS*, it is contemplated that the Agency will join in the execution of a mortgage (together with any and all related financing documents) which shall not exceed TWO HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND AND 00/100 (\$250,000.00) DOLLARS in favor of the Bank.

# NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MEMBERS OF THE AGENCY AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The Chairman, Executive Director or Chief Executive Officer of the Agency, each acting individually, are each hereby authorized, on behalf of the Agency, to execute and deliver a mortgage (together with any and all related financing documents) which shall not exceed TWO HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND AND 00/100 (\$250,000.00) DOLLARS in favor of the Bank, all in form approved by Counsel to the Agency and with such changes, variations, omissions and insertions as the Chairman, Executive Director or Chief Executive Officer of the Agency shall approve, the execution thereof by the Chairman, Executive Director or Chief Executive Officer of the Agency to constitute conclusive evidence of such approval.
- Section 2. The officers, employees and agents of the Agency are hereby authorized and directed for and in the name and on behalf of the Agency to do all acts and things required and to execute and deliver all such certificates, instruments, documents, and to pay all such fees, charges and expenses and to do all such further acts and things as may be necessary or in the opinion of the officer, employee or agent acting on behalf of the Agency desirable and proper to effect the purposes of the foregoing resolutions and to cause compliance by the Agency with all the terms, covenants and provisions of the documents for and on behalf of the Agency.

## <u>Section 3.</u> These resolutions shall take effect immediately.
