Resolution No. 37 - 17

***RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING THE EXECUTION AND DELIVERY OF A MORTGAGE (AND RELATED FINANCING DOCUMENTS) IN FAVOR OF JEFF BANK (“BANK”) IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$700,000 DOLLARS RELATING TO THE ROLLING V BUS CORP. (“COMPANY”) PROJECT***

***WHEREAS***, by Title 1 of Article 18-A of the General Municipal Law of the State of New York (“State”), as amended, and Chapter 560 of the Laws of 1970 of the State of New York, (hereinafter collectively called the "Act"), the Agency was created with the authority and power to promote, develop, encourage and assist in acquiring, constructing, reconstructing, improving, maintaining, equipping and furnishing industrial, manufacturing, warehousing, commercial, civic, research, and recreational facilities as authorized by the Act, and enter into straight lease transactions and provide other forms of financial assistance; and

**WHEREAS**, on September 1, 2006, the Company and Dimifini Group, Inc. closed on a sale/leaseback transaction consisting of the following: (i) construction, installation and equipping an expansion to the Company's existing building to consist of an approximately 2025± square feet ("Building") situate on one (1) parcel of real estate consisting of approximately 3.26± acres to be located at 5008 Main Street in the Town of Fallsburg, County of Sullivan, State of New York and identified on the Town of Fallsburg tax map as Section 60, Block 1, Lot 28.3 ("Land") intended to be used as office and training space and related facilities to be owned by the Agency; (ii) acquisition and installation thereon and therein of certain furniture, fixtures, machinery, equipment and tools ("Equipment"); (iii) construction of improvements to the Building, the Land and the Equipment (collectively, the Building, the Land and the Equipment are referred to as the "Facility" or the "Project"); and (iv) lease of the Facility from the Agency to the Company; and

**WHEREAS**, by Bargain and Sale Deed, made September 1, 2006 from Dimifini Group, Inc. to the Agency and recorded in the Sullivan County Clerk's Office on September 26, 2006 as in Liber 3224 at Page 605; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to a Commitment Letter, dated May 5, 2017, the Bank has approved a Commercial Line of Credit in an amount not to exceed SEVEN HUNDRED THOUSAND AND 00/100 (\$700,000.00) Dollars; and

**WHEREAS**, it is contemplated that the Agency will join in the execution of a mortgage (together with any and all related financing documents) which shall not exceed SEVEN HUNDRED THOUSAND AND 00/100 (\$700,000.00) Dollars in favor of the Bank thereby abating mortgage recording tax thereon.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MEMBERS OF THE AGENCY AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. The Chairman, Executive Director or Chief Executive Officer of the Agency, each acting individually, are each hereby authorized, on behalf of the Agency, to execute and deliver a mortgage (together with any and all related financing documents) in favor of the Bank which in an amount not to exceed SEVEN HUNDRED THOUSAND AND 00/100 (\$700,000.00) DOLLARS thereby abating mortgage tax in an aggregating amount not to exceed SEVEN THOUSAND AND 00/100 (\$7,000) DOLLARS all in form approved by Counsel to the Agency and with such changes, variations, omissions and insertions as the Chairman, Executive Director or Chief Executive Officer of the Agency shall approve, the execution thereof by the Chairman, Executive Director or Chief Executive Officer of the Agency to constitute conclusive evidence of such approval.

Section 2. The officers, employees and agents of the Agency are hereby authorized and directed for and in the name and on behalf of the Agency to do all acts and things required and to execute and deliver all such certificates, instruments, documents, and to pay all such fees, charges and expenses and to do all such further acts and things as may be necessary or in the opinion of the officer, employee or agent acting

on behalf of the Agency desirable and proper to effect the purposes of the foregoing resolutions and to cause compliance by the Agency with all the terms, covenants and provisions of the documents for and on behalf of the Agency.

Section 3. These resolutions shall take effect immediately.
