RESOLUTION OF THE AGENCY APPROVING AN INCREASE IN THE AUTHORIZED SALES AND USE TAX ABATEMENT RELATING TO THE HUDSUT LLC AND HVFG LLC (COLLECTIVELY, THE "COMPANY") PROJECT

WHEREAS, by Title 1 of Article 18-A of the General Municipal Law of the State of New York ("State"), as amended, and Chapter 560 of the Laws of 1970 of the State, as amended and codified as Section 960 of the General Municipal Law (collectively, the "Act"), the Agency was created with the authority and power to own, lease and sell property as authorized by the Act; and

WHEREAS, on or about March 1, 2017, the Company and the Agency entered into an Agent and Project Agreement ("Agent Agreement") and an Environmental Compliance and Indemnification Agreement ("ECIA") and entered into a Bill of Sale, Amended and Restated Lease Agreement and Amended and Restated Payment in Lieu of Tax Agreement ("Transaction Documents"); and

WHEREAS, contemporaneously with signing the Transaction Documents, the Company and the Agency closed an assignment and assumption transaction consisting of the: (A) reconstruction and equipping of the two (2) existing buildings ("Buildings") to include (1) an installation of a 5,000 square foot freezer ("Freezer"); and (2) construction of processing rooms; (B) installation thereon and therein of certain furniture fixtures, machinery and equipment ("Equipment"); (C) the installation of the Freezer and the processing rooms and related improvements to the Buildings, the Equipment and other improvements therein; and (D) the Land (collectively referred to as the "Facility" or "Project") and (E) the lease of the Facility from the Agency to the Company; and

WHEREAS, by resolution duly adopted on November 28, 2016, the Agency approved the Project and in connection therewith authorized a sales and use tax exemption in an amount not to exceed Thirty-Four Thousand Two Hundred Eighty-Two and 00/100 (\$34,282.00) Dollars; and

WHEREAS, the cost of the Project will exceed the amounts listed in the application originally submitted; and

WHEREAS, the Company requested an increase in the authorized amount of the sales and use tax exemption not to exceed Seventy Thousand and 00/100 (\$70,000.00) Dollars; and

WHEREAS, the direct and indirect benefits to the local economy of additional construction activity far exceeds to cost of the increased sales and use tax exemption.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MEMBERS OF THE AGENCY AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The Agency hereby approves the Company's request to increase the authorized sales and use tax abatement to an amount not to exceed Seventy Thousand and 00/100 (\$70,000.00) Dollars conditioned upon payment of all fees and costs of the Agency related hereto.
- Section 2. The Executive Director, Chief Executive Officer or Counsel to the Agency is hereby authorized and directed (i) to distribute copies of this resolution to the Company; and (ii) to do such further things or perform such acts and to execute any and all documents as may be necessary or convenient to implement the provisions of this resolution.
- Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
